

VICAR'S LETTER: By the time you read this in May, and by Sunday

1st May I should be 13 days into my 36 day almost 1,000km pilgrimage from Seville to Santiago and my walking plan suggests I will be in a place called Grimaldo, a small village in central Spain. Hopefully at this stage I will be de-stressed and beginning the process of reflecting on almost 10 years of ministry in the Frome Valley and listening to God as I re-charge my spiritual batteries. As I write this just before Easter I am still in the midst of one of the busiest periods of ministry that I can remember. I still have 2 funerals to take during Holy Week along with more Annual Parochial Church Meetings, Holy Week services and Easter services to prepare for.



Knowing that I'm not the only member of clergy in the Diocese who is completely worn out doesn't always help. I'm looking forward to the joy of Easter Sunday, but I'm also looking forward to getting away from it all.


One of the tensions I constantly live with is knowing how much it costs to have me here in the benefice and also knowing what pressures the churches are under to pay towards the cost of ministry. At a PCC meeting recently I asked a churchwarden if they thought my ministry was worth the £1,000 that the church pays towards the cost of our £67,000 share of ministry - they said no. I was very sad to hear that I'm not worth £19 a week to one of my churchwardens.


Other tensions arise when people don't get what they want, or 'what they pay for'. It seems that everyone is looking for value for money – and the only place they see this is on Sundays. The ministry that continues relentlessly throughout the week is not on most people's radar, and I understand that. But, do people really believe that if a church pays say £3,000 a year towards ministry (that's £58 a week) that they should have every service they demand? Or that if I can't cover a service myself that I should be able to pluck another priest out of nowhere for them?


One of the great joys of services in Lent was that Bishops Frome church was closed due to ceiling repairs. Why was this a joy? Because they held some of their service in Much Cowarne. Somehow we seem to have managed to move the entire congregation from one church to another without any problem and it was a great blessing for both congregations.

The idea that we can only practice our faith in our local church, that clergy can cover every service we might want and that we can continue to get away with paying £20 a week for the Vicar is completely unrealistic. We simply can't carry on like this. Below is a simple pie chart

which explains the costs of ministry that a benefice such as ours should be trying it's best to cover. Some of our churches give generously and plan to increase giving next year. Others receive additional income but keep it for a rainy day. With the Diocese left to subsidise the parishes leaving them with a £1.02 Million deficit I think the rainy day has already arrived.

April 2022

Last month I went on a 'ward tour' with Mike Brookes, our Balfour Beatty Locality Steward (ie the person who keeps an eye on the issues re the roads in our ward). It was very useful and I plan to repeat it regularly, as I used to do with the previous incumbent pre-Covid.

One of the locations we inspected was the place outside the surgery in Cradley that was recently flooded (again). By the time of our visit, the flood had thankfully been pumped out – but I was frustrated to see that the road and



pavement were still covered in mud, and indeed the drains themselves were hidden under the mud. Mike agreed with me that this is simply not acceptable. A few days later, he had arranged for the mud to be scraped from the road, but the drains and the pavement were still muddy, so I chased this up again. As I write this I am on holiday for a week and have not been able to recently inspect the site, but I very much hope that by the time Cradley residents read this the mud will finally all have been removed. I am just sorry that it has taken so long... grrr...

Another frustrating issue has been the signage at the A4103 / B4214 junction at the bottom of Fromes Hill. Following numerous emails from me, temporary additional warning signs were installed here; and I continue to chase BBLP to install the permanent new signage which I hope will significantly reduce the incidence of accidents in this location. Again, I am frustrated that this has taken so long, despite me chasing it every week since January... I'm sorry about this and am trying my best to get quicker action on these key road safety issues.

Last month I started my column reflecting on the horrors of war in Ukraine and the support the county is providing for refugees. I learned this month that there are also still over 15,000 Syrian refugees in temporary accommodation across the UK following the evacuation last August. I am pleased to report that Herefordshire has taken our fair share of these refugees, and is working hard to support Ukrainian refugees too.

At the last Cabinet meeting, we approved an additional £11.49 million funding for children's social care services. This is a significant extra investment, designed to address the longstanding problems (dating back nearly ten years) in children's social care, that were highlighted by a critical court judgement in April 2021. With a new administration, a new chief executive and a new head of children's services, the council has fully recognised the need for root and branch reform. This commitment of additional funding signals the seriousness with which we are all addressing the problems. We want Herefordshire to be a place where every child is safe and well cared for.

Also at the last Cabinet meeting we approved Market Town Investment Plans for all the five Herefordshire market towns (Bromyard, Ledbury, Ross, Kington and Leominster). This is the first time that a council administration has made a specific effort to identify investment needs and potential in the market towns. I often say that that county's economy is like a three-legged stool: city, market towns, and rural areas — as residents of this ward know, we have many thriving rural businesses! We are currently developing a Herefordshire-wide proposal to the government's Levelling Up Fund and I very much hope that market town investment will be a central part of this.

As usual, I am running out of space! So I'll just close with a reminder about my monthly ward surgeries (just drop in, no appointment needed):

- Bishops Frome Village Centre, 3rd Tuesday of each month, 1.00-2.30pm
- Cradley Village Hall, 3rd Thursday of each month, 1.00-2.30pm.

And finally – if you fancy joining me for a bit of litter-picking or sign-cleaning or general spring-cleaning in the ward, do get in touch and come and join me on the second Sunday of every month, 10am to 12 midday for my 'Sunday Service'. I'll provide litter-pickers and hi-viz!

Listen out for the cuckoo while you can

It is early April as I write and I haven't yet heard my first cuckoo of the year, but it shouldn't be long. There is something quite special about the distinctive call of the cuckoo. It tells me summer is coming. Sadly, our cuckoo population continues to decline – by more than 50% in the last 25 years. These fascinating birds overwinter in central Africa, but they face many challenges on their journey to Europe and climate change is not helping. The British Trust for Ornithology (BTO) is carrying out long-term research into this species.
